TNReady is the state of Tennessee's assessment for students in grades 3 – 8 and high school in the areas of math and English as well as other applicable subjects. TNReady assesses students on their real understanding of material, not just rote memorization or test-taking tricks. TNReady also measure whether students are developing the real-world skills needed for the next grade and for life after high school – critical thinking, problem solving, and communication.

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The TNReady is given in two parts. Part 1 is scheduled during the window of February 22, 2016 – March 18, 2016. Shelby County Schools will not begin testing Part I no earlier than

March 7, 2016. Part 2 is scheduled during the window of April 26 - May 6, 2016. You will be notified on the exact dates testing

will take place at Fairley STEAM Academy. Students with resource services may have various

accommodations on the TNReady as determined by their current IEP. Review your child's IEP to see if he/she have specific accommodations. Please call Ms.
